HEALING And S Local Nurse Uses Her

Success to Motivate Others

orking in the medical field as a registered nurse
(RN) in the bariatric department at Singing River
Health System, Tenerta Roberts has seen illness
of every kind. The 39-year-old RN from Moss Point has stood
beside countless patients as they made important life decisions
regarding their treatment.

"Watching them make these tough decisions was a reality check for me," said Roberts. "Many of my patients came to a point in their treatment where there were few options left. While I wasn't dealing with medical problems of my own at the time, I knew I was overweight and I knew what my future would be if I dish't do something to introse one health."

Having worked alongside the surgeons from the South Mississippi Surgical Weight Low Center (SMSWLC) before, Roberts says selecting them was a no brainer. "I saw how their surgeons worked postoperatively with their patients, I was familiar with the team and comfortable with the journey that SMSWLC offered."

For Roberts, that journey started with selecting her surgeon. "Yee worked with Dr. Aozra for almost 16 years now," she recalled. "He's one of the surgeons who started our Center for Excellence at Singing River Hospital, so who better to choose? I took care of many of his hatratise patients from day one. He's the kind of doctor who talks to you as if you're at a barkyard barbecto. He'll let you knew wiley what you're doing in not working and what you should be doing innotat."

Avara is known for letting his patients know that buriantic surgery inn't the easy way out – in's simply a tool that, pained with hard work and a strong support system, can offer patients their greatest chance for success. "I'm bucky in that 1 get to experience that success over and over again," says Roberts. "Cetting to share my experience with my patients is the best feeling ever.
